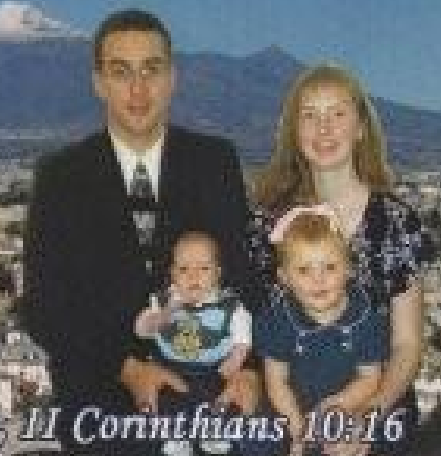

We would like to begin by praising the Lord for the things that have transpired the past few months. God has allowed us to travel in many states. Our travels have taken us from western Texas to the very top of Michigan. We have been in quite a number of churches across this country. God has also blessed with many churches becoming a part of our ministry. The blessings of the Lord are so many that I cannot begin to recount them to you but I will try for a few minutes.

God allowed us to be at the Lighthouse Baptist Church in Grand Prairie, Texas in the months of January and February. God enabled us to be able to help this church in a great way and they were a great blessing to us as well. The church was in great need of repair with their 14,000 square foot roof. There were parts of the roof that had over two inches of standing water! Some areas of the roof had deteriorated so much that you could actually fall through. This job would have cost this church approximately \$50,000. God allowed us put a new metal roof on this church for about \$18,000! It was truly a blessing to be able to help this church in this way. This church was also a great blessing to us. They allowed us to stay in their prophets chamber and we were able to be in a different church every Sunday morning, Sunday evening, and Wednesday night. God has raised up many churches who have expressed an interest in our ministry as a result of this trip. I was blessed with the privilege of preaching in two Bible colleges as well. Not only are we trying to raise up financial and prayer support, we are also trying to encourage young people to surrender to the will of God for their lives whether it be on a foreign mission field or at home.

While we were in Texas, God allowed me to lead three Mexican young men to the Lord! What a blessing! Each of these young men allowed us to explain the scriptures to them and then prayed to receive Christ. What a blessing that God is still saving sinners. We cannot wait until God begins to allow us to lead many Mexicans to Christ in Puebla.

Our travels took us from Texas, through Alabama, around by North Carolina, and then up to Michigan and Wisconsin. There were several churches that have taken the ministry on for support in the northern part of the United States. Some of these churches were hesitant because they did not have great finances. However, any amount is a great blessing. Some of these churches told me they could not do a lot but they could do a little. It would only take 40 churches at \$25 dollars a month to be at full support. I know that it sounds like a lot but we have been in 150 churches that do not yet support us. I implore you to pray that God would burden the hearts of these churches to see the need of reaching a city of 2,000,000 with the Gospel.

The urgency to go there increases every day. As we hear of the drug problems, my heart yearns to reach them with the Gospel. The only way to cure the drug problem in Mexico is to win these people to Christ. How many souls will die without ever hearing the Good News of salvation? We have the answer to their sin problem but how shall they hear without a preacher?

I want to thank those of you who support this ministry. Your prayers and finances are greatly appreciated. We want to be in Mexico before Christmas this year. Please pray that God will raise up the remainder of our support. Please also pray for safety on the highways as we travel to many churches this year. Thank you all once more and may God bless you as you endeavor to serve Him.
