Dear Friends in Christ,

We just received this message about a week ago from the United States Consulate General Guadalajara Mexico and asked us to circulate this message to as many American Citizens as Possible. We live almost 2 hours from Guadalajara. Here is the US Consulate Message:

SUBJECT: WARDEN MESSAGE **Date: June 29, 2010** **BEGIN TEXT:** "American citizens should be aware of the fact that the security environment within Guadalajara's consular district continues to deteriorate. Mexican officials recently commented on the security situation in Guadalajara saying that police are unable to effectively combat organized crime and drug cartel violence, and this could affect innocent civilians. Drug cartel violence continues to be on the rise within the greater Guadalajara Metropolitan area. On June 24th there was a confrontation between police and cartel fighters on the road between Guadalajara and the nearby tourist destination of Mazamitla. Multiple gun battles between rival drug cartels and police involving automatic assault rifles, armored vehicles, and grenades have been reported closer and closer to Guadalajara this also includes the recent heavy weapon fights in Tepic, Nayarit where the Governor recently ordered the early closure of public schools due to the cartel violence."

We are not in immediate danger for the moment. If we sense a serious threat we are ready to pack up and head out. None of us have a martyr's complex, but if it is God's will that we are to die in Mexico for His names sake then so let it be. We pray that we will be faithful even unto death.

We do have a praise; our son Rey III just got married to Ruth on May 22. We were able to make it to the wedding and everything went so well. Pray for them as they make their adjustments and prepare for the ministry.

We also want you to rejoice with us in the baptism of Sra. Rosa, Alejandro, Erica, Sr. Rolando and Lalo. These precious souls took a big step of faith in following our Lords command in getting baptized. The devil will be fighting them constantly in order to destroy their testimony and to discourage them from serving the Lord.

Mr. Rolando and his family all accepted Christ as their Saviour, except for one of their sons named Alfredo. We are praying for this young man, he prefers the world more than the true and living God. Of those that got saved one of them was the mother of Rolando. She was attending faithfully a Pentecostal Unity Church (a cult). After several Bible studies she visited our church and liked it and on June 20th she took a stand and decided to leave the false church completely. The people from her old church have been calling her trying to pull her back. She has made it clear to them that she will not be returning.

Pray for Lalo's parents. They are not coming faithfully. We have visited them and they always make excuses as to why they cannot make it. Lalo is faithful to all our services. He does the scripture reading in church every Sunday morning. This young man is growing spiritually and is a tremendous blessing to all of us.

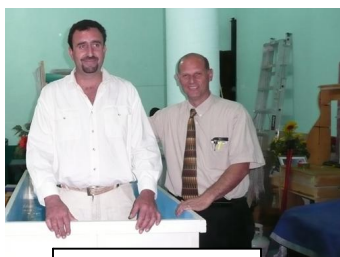
