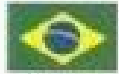

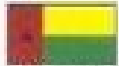

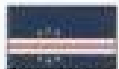

We are at 91% in our support level and praying that the Lord will complete the remaining support needed for our family and ministry. We would like to thank the churches who have faithfully supported us till now, through our internship, and deputation. Without your Faith and Encouragement the road would have been a lot longer. Thank you.

Currently, we are a "house divided". Sarah, my lovely wife is in America, tending to our toddler (Mason) and expecting any day now to deliver our second son (Micah Edward Pritchard). I on the other hand, am here in Cape Verde. My tasks for the last two and a half weeks have been that of arranging a place for us to live in the city of Assomada, CV. Also including the laborious job of getting a container out of port. Please read previous prayer letters to know what this container is for. I would ask that you please pray, for this process can often get quite complicated in a jiffy. We rest assured that the Lord knows exactly what is needed at exactly the right time.

Our plan is for me to return to the U.S. the May 16, 2012. Hopefully in time to see our son born. Following his birth, and with the collection of certain crucial documents, my family and I plan to leave for Cape Verde around mid-June.

The city of Assomada is where we plan to start a church, please be in prayer about this that we will follow the Lord's guidance, and accomplish His perfect will in this place. The 50,000 plus people that live in this place are in need of a Saviour, and He is due their glory.
